

## ***Meeting Minutes***

May 09, 2011

Meeting was called to order by President Chuck Baker at 7:41pm.

### ***Old Business***

Treasurer Matt offered a detailed report. With no questions the Treasurers report was approved and accepted. Matt reported that the road fund stands at \$540.00

President Chuck reported on his experiences at the SEFF electric fly in Georgia. Great week of flying.

### ***New Business***

As reported on the club web site the flying field has suffered some damage from vandals. The flying field will require some filling and seeding and this can be done about the same time as road repairs. Thanks to the efforts of some and especially Duane Wright the field is in much better shape after a bit of work on the damage. A work crew will need to be assembled to work on both the road and the field. A signup sheet was passed around asking for volunteers. Duane and Jerry Sharp will co-ordinate repair efforts.

Road and field repair costs estimated up to \$300 for the damage was put to a vote and passed unanimously. Included is grinding of the road to level the high spots, top soil for the field damage along with seed and fertilizer. Part of this money has been donated for road repairs but the field damage will come out of the general fund. We may ask for donations to cover this so that the general fund remains in the black.

Also put to a vote and approved by the members present was the purchase and installation of plastic drainage pipe under the portion of the access road that seems to suffer most every winter. This drainage pipe should help with this problem. Funds were approved up to \$200 for this work. Jerry Sharp to co-ordinate. Thanks Jerry.

Last piece of road business is the purchase and spreading of additional gravel. Jerry Sharp has solicited quotations and has a great price of \$210 per load. Looks like we will need at least 2 loads. This money will come out of the road fund donations.

The A-10 build challenge has been answered and won by our own Eric Munevar. Eric displayed a very nice A-10 and was presented a \$50 gift certificate for his efforts. Congrats Eric!
