Pres. Duane announced that the FAA will shortly publish the new rules for (Registration and Marking for Small Unmanned Aircraft. These rules require the following:

1. Interim Final Rule Requirements

- A. Unmanned aircraft weighting less than 55 pounds and more than 0.55 pounds (0.55 grams) on takeoff, including everything that is on board or otherwise attached to the aircraft and operated outdoors in the national airspace system must register.
- B. Register by February 19, 2015, for small unmanned aircraft to be used exclusively as model aircraft and have been operated by their owner prior to December 21, 2015.
- C. Persons 13 years of age and older are permitted to use part 48 process to register a small unmanned aircraft. If the owner is less than 13 years of age, then the small unmanned aircraft must be registered by a person who is at least 13 years of age.
- D. Registration will occur through an online web-based system.
- E. Certificate of Aircraft Registration and registration number issued to an individual intending to use small unmanned aircraft exclusively as model aircraft, constitutes registration for those small unmanned aircraft owned by that individual that are intended to be used exclusively as model aircraft.
- F. Required information from individuals registering small unmanned aircraft intended to be used exclusively as model aircraft.
 - (1) Applicant name.
 - (2) Applicant physical address (and mailing address if different than physical address).
 - (3) Applicant e-mail address.
- G. \$ 5 to register and individual's fleet of small unmanned aircraft.
- H. Upon completion of the registration process, the Certificate of Aircraft registration will be delivered to the aircraft owner via the same web-based platform used to register the aircraft.
 - (1) Small unmanned aircraft owner name, issued date and registration number.
- I. A Certificate of Aircraft Registration issued in accordance with part 48 is effective once the registration process is completed and must be renewed every three years.
 - (1) The fee for renewal of a Certificated of Aircraft Registration is \$5.

- J A small unmanned aircraft must display a unique identifier.
(1) A unique identifier is the FAA-issued registration number.
(2) The Administrator may authorize the use of the small unmanned aircraft serial number.
