Old Business

The purchase of grub control chemicals was discussed. The material is \$30 / bag and approximately 8 bags will be needed for the field.

Overall, spring field repairs, Grub Control and the New Roller will cost less than \$500. A request was made to fund this though a special donation. A motion was made and seconded. It was agreed that if there is not enough given as part of the donation drive, the remaining will come from the general fund.

Doug Gifford has volunteered to be the Field Safety Officer for 2018. Doug will be working with Bob Badger to update the Field Safety Manual to match the way we all fly with mostly electric aircraft. The updates will be reviewed at the April meeting.


