

# **Meeting Minutes**

August 13, 2018



# Regular August meeting at the club field with President Rick Taylor presiding. The weather was pleasant with low winds

The meeting was called to order by President Rick Taylor at 7:10 pm.

23 (approx.) Members + 2 Officers present (Adam Hunt was away on business). Three visitors were present.

#### **Old Business**

Treasurer Doug Gifford read the July 2018 treasurer's report. Motion made and seconded and membership voted unanimously to accept the report.

Vice President Adam Hunt was not present to read the July meeting minutes. Doug Gifford summarized the minutes as published by Adam. No corrections or changes were brought forth at this time.



#### Recent Events -

Saturday, August 4th – Greenwood Airport Day – Indy RC South members ran a booth with AMA and club information and numerous model aircraft and quadcopters on display. A P-51 Mustang, a PT-19 and a T-28 Trojan were on display. EAA's Young Eagles program was providing flight experiences for local kids. Tom Theison had an opportunity to sit in the cockpit of the P-51 but, to his extreme disappointment, he was not permitted to fly it. Our booth location was good and the event coordinator, Roger Tomi, expressed his desire to have us return next year possibly with space for flight demonstrations.

## Training -

Al Tucker mentioned that Rodney (last name not known), a full scale pilot, was at the field on training night last Thursday and is interested in learning to fly RC.

#### **New Business -**

Barb Middleton informed the membership that Sonictronics and McDaniels had provided 20 catalogs and would offer a discount of 35% off retail for a group club order. Members were to see Barb to place orders.

Doug Gifford led a discussion regarding a field operating rules addition. At our April meeting changes to our Field Operating Rules were presented, discussed and approved that dealt with our field operations and the considerable shift of flying to light weight electric powered aircraft. Prior to this August meeting a proposed change had been communicated to the membership regarding the labeling requirements for aircraft. An item was added reading "Aircraft weighing more than 0.55 pounds and flown outdoors must be labelled per AMA (owner address or AMA #) and per FAA requirements (UAS "modeler" registration number)." This change is a result of recent FAA rulings that finally became law in December 2017 (FAA Small UAS rule Part 107) and have been endorsed by the AMA. It was agreed by those present that this needed to be added to our Field Operating Rules.
