Rike Field Viability

Jon Taylor (Rike Field Land Owner) has informed the club that there is a pending sale of an additional 40 acres that would limit or prohibit the club from using the established flyover area used safely since the mid-70's.



Duane gave a brief history of the club and previous threats of field loss. First serious threat of field loss was in the 1990s. This threat diminished through the 2000s. The club accounts were kept above \$10,000 to help with field relocation if ever needed.

Geotex project has been put on hold pending confirmation of field viability. New field search committee will be formed to look for suitable locations in Shelby County or Franklin County.

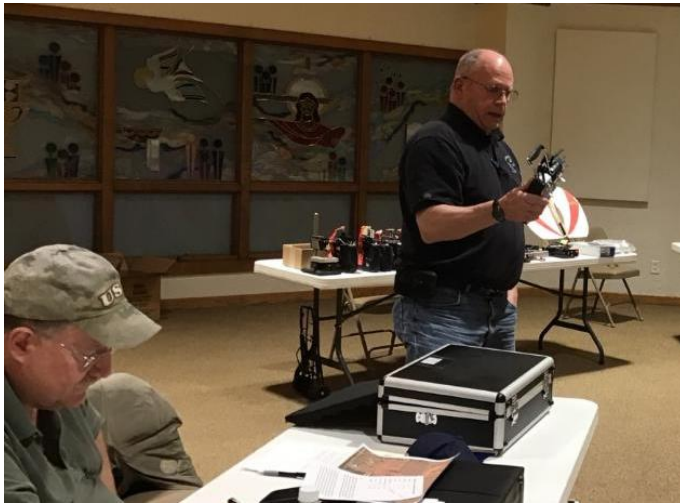
