 - #10 (2.7 NNE) W of 904 N Matthews Rd (Robinson Airport) – (Bob Badger)
 - 9/14 – Spoke with Dr. Robinson – location will not work, but he is supportive and will look for us.
 - #46 (1.6 SE) W of 6534 Hurricane Rd (Ryan Westerhold - Airport)
 - 9/29 – His location is not viable, but he is still looking for us. Suggested I contact Bruce Daugherty
- Potential Flying Sites (still viable):
 - #39 (2.0 S) S of 600N/250E, northeast-facing small aircraft field parallel to interstate (Rob Kent)
 - 10/7 – Called again, talked to secretary. She said that she or Jeff will call me back.
 - #40 (11.0 WNW) E of Mann Rd, S of Ralston, north-facing sport flyer field (Erik Munevar)
 - 10/7 – Found attorney in MO, asked if they have contact info.
 - 10/7 – Called Indiana American Water (sign), but they didn't know the owner.
 - #41 (12.25 WNW) E of Cox Rd between Ralston/Landersdale, east-facing small aircraft field (Erik Munevar)
 - 10/7 – Contacted agent David Shelton to see if he has a response from the landowner
 - #47 (6.0 S) NE of Franklin, IN at 1480 400 E (Nick Shergi - Airport)
 - Offered to let us come down and fly off his full-scale strip 2x month (Sundays).
 - 10/7 – Still trying to arrange for a site visit.
 - #50 (11.4 S) E of 200 E, S of E 300 S, east of Franklin Flying Field (Jerry McRoberts)
 - Airport changed hands on 9/1 (guys from Mooresville), Jerry is working this.
 - 10/8 – Trying to make a site visit to talk to new landowners.
 - #51 (5.7 SE) E of 625E, S of 350N, hayfield behind house at 3093 N 625E (Rick Sallee)
 - 9/10 - Visited landowner – very interested and ready to rent to us
 - 9/11 – Duane visited – no longer interested due to increased expenses (attorney)
 - 9/15 – Let him know we would not change his zoning/taxes. He will talk to his lawyer/son
 - #52 (4.1 ENE) NW of Rocklane Rd and Acton Rd (Leawana Wheatcraft)
 - 9/23 – Left a message, called back, they have a paraglider grass strip
 - 10/7 – Still trying to arrange a site visit.

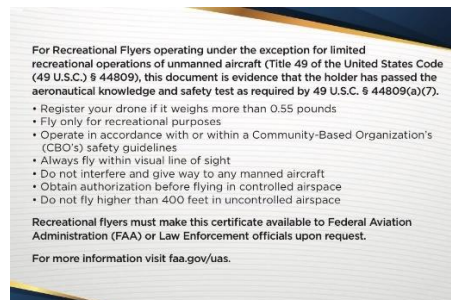
New Business

FAA Registration Renewals are becoming due for several of the original applicants. The following link can be used to access the registration site

Take the TRUST test if you haven't already.

Proof of test completion (Completion Certificate) must be able to be produced if requested by FAA or law enforcement.



The Indianapolis RC Modelers (Morristown) club has graciously agreed to let Indy RC South members in good standing with current AMA fly for free at their field through September of 2022.

2.4 GHz interference at Camp Atterbury may have been an isolated aircraft or radio issue. No new complaints in several weeks with multiple uneventful flights being made.

A motion was made by Dave Griffith and seconded by Bob Badger to cut the 2022 dues rates for Indy RC South in half for 2022 until a new field is under agreement. The standard single member dues of \$80 will be \$40 if paid prior to securing a new flying field. Other due rates will similarly be halved.

Fall Picnic. Since Rike Field is still open, the club will plan on having a fall picnic at the field on October 30, 2021. Chuck will send out a request for side dishes.

Brent Shultz at Center Grove HS is planning on having indoor flying sessions available this winter. More information about dates and times will be sent when they are received.

Annual Holiday Party at Dye's Walk in January 2022. 16 people indicated interest. Dye's Walk indicates that most weekends are available.
