- #47 (6.0 S) NE of Franklin, IN at 1480 400 E (Nick Shergi Airport)
 - Offered to let us come down and fly off his full-scale strip 2x month (Sundays).
 - 1st invite scheduled for Sun 11/7 @ 1pm.
- #50 (11.4 S) E of 200 E, S of E 300 S, east of Franklin Flying Field (Jerry McRoberts)
 - Need to wait a month for site visit, after new owners take possession.
- #51 (5.7 SE) E of 625E, S of 350N, hayfield behind house at 3093 N 625E (Rick Sallee)
 - Visited landowner Initially very interested and ready to rent to us zoning/taxes questions
 - He has invited us to come try out the field, and his neighbors delayed until spring

2022 Dues
