

Meeting Minutes

Monday, August 8, 2022

Meeting was held at Dye's Walk.

Meeting was called to order by President Chuck Baker at 7:30 pm.

15 members, 3 officers and 3 guests were in attendance.

Old Business

Adam Hunt read the July meeting minutes. There were no questions concerning the minutes. A motion to approve the meeting minutes was made and seconded. The minutes were approved as read by a show of hands.

Doug read the Treasurer's Report. July income was \$395.07, and expenses were \$202.64 (raffle item & field search flyers). There were no questions concerning the report. A motion to approve the treasurer's report was made and seconded. The report was approved as read by a show of hands.

Rike Field Viability & New Field Search

As a reminder, Rike Field was Officially Closed on October 28, 2021. Contruction has begun. Old shelters have been demolished and earth is being moved.

- #51 (5.7 SE) E of 625E, S of 350N, hayfield behind house at 3093 N 625E (Rick Sallee)
 - Discuss results of 7/4 Test Fly session 13 flyers show Rick Taylor video
 - General consensus from club too small, temporary might be last resort

- #63 (15.0 WSW) NW of SR 37, about 3.5 miles SW of Waverly, IN (Roger Waldrip)
 - North-facing sport flyer field, mailed info, called, and left message.
 - Got a voicemail from 1 of 3 trustees land currently being farmed, asked where we wanted to set up and if we were insured. Responded asking for email address to respond to her queries.
- #64 (15.3 WSW) N of Cemetery Rd, W of Perry Rd, 4 miles SW of Waverly, IN (Roger Waldrip)
 - North-facing sport flyer field. Spoke to receptionist, will forward info, I-69 mediation until Nov.
 - Followed up with receptionist to verify info sent
- #65 (6.0 SW) Land E of 150W, between 350N & 400N, 2 miles ENE of Bargersville, IN (Chip Hurkmans)
 - Owner passed 2016, spoke to daughter, sent her info, she will review and discuss with family.
 - Have checked with Johannah several times, but she is not responding.
- #68 Guy that cuts Chip Hurkmans' hay knows might be able to help us out East of Bargersville.
 - He used to farm Jon's land and his dad is friends with Jon. They should know what we need as far as flying area.
 - Talked to the dad. They might sell in a few years Chip is still working on them.
- #69 (5.4 S) Land E of Graham Rd/250E, North of Franklin (Dennis Hoggatt JCRCF)
 - Owner appears to have full scale airstrip No phone. Will mail information then visit.

Doug Gifford gave an update on the latest Mickey's Camp which was held at Bradford Woods. John Gaither organizes this event to educate local businessmen about drones.




Next Club Meeting
