

## **Meeting Minutes**

Monday, September 12, 2022

Meeting was held at Dye's Walk.

Several members showed up early to enjoy a tasty dinner at Dye's Walk.



Meeting was called to order by President Chuck Baker at 7:36 pm because we were waiting for Doug to finish dinner.

17 members, 3 officers and 1 guest were in attendance.

#### **Old Business**

Adam Hunt read the August meeting minutes. There were no questions concerning the minutes. A motion to approve the meeting minutes was made and seconded. The minutes were approved as read by a show of hands.

Doug read the Treasurer's Report. August income was \$185.08, and expenses were \$159.99 (raffle item). If any member wishes to have a copy of the treasurer's report, please contact Doug. Total current paid membership for 2022 is 38 (compared to 52 in 2021 at the same point). There were no questions concerning the report. A motion to approve the treasurer's report was made and seconded. The report was approved as read by a show of hands.



#### **New Field Search Status**

#### Potential Flying Sites no Longer Viable:

- #68 (???) Guy that cuts Chip Hurkman's hay might be able to help us out east of Bargersville.
  - o Father not interested in helping us out Chip will try again next time he talks to son.
- #69 (5.4 S) Land E of Graham Rd/250E, north of Franklin (Dennis Hoggatt JCRCF)
  - Owner appears to have full scale airstrip Talked to son, they are NOT interested.
- #71 (9.25 SW) Land SW of 100N/SR 135 intersection (Tonya Munevar)
  - o Land owned by out-of-state investors, would be S facing field, not viable.
- #72/#73 (6.0 WSW) Field E of SR 135, S of 700N (Tonya Munevar)
  - Would be N facing field with gravel drive, but is already being developed, not viable.

## Potential Flying Sites Still Viable:

- #65 (6.0 SW) Land E of 150W, between 350N & 400N, 2 miles ENE of Bargersville, IN (Chip Hurkmans)
  - o E facing field off of 150W, spoke to daughter, left message with her mom
- #70 (???) Contacted by Jerry Navarro, aviation enthusiast who moved here from Nashville
  - o Realty company (music business), might have areas that would work, no word yet.
- #74 (7.0 SW) Land W of SR 135, N of Hwy 144, E of Golden Post Kennel (Tonya Munevar).
  - N facing small/electric field north of gravel drive. Have sent query to kennel.
- #75 (1.4 SE) Land S of 700N, W of Hurricane Creek (contacted by James Reisert)
  - o Existing gravel drive/pad, ESE facing small field, might be electric only.
  - O Site visit went well, but wife is concerned about traffic, noise, hours baked goods?
  - o Trying to schedule a flying demo to alleviate wife/neighbor concerns.
- #76 (10.3 NE) Land E of 650W, N of 1100N, about 2 miles SSW of New Palestine (Joshua Stephens)
  - o Small N facing field, may need gravel drive, 27 mins from old field, need to make site visit.
- #77 (9.0 SW) Land S of 100N, E of SR135 owned by John Kephart (suggested by Nick Shergi)
  - o E facing field east of gravel drive, west of N-S full-scale runway, mailed info will call later


The flight simulator was a big hit again this year.


