Old Business

Adam Hunt read the October meeting minutes. There were no questions concerning the minutes. A motion to approve the meeting minutes was made and seconded. The minutes were approved as read by a show of hands.

Doug read the Treasurer's Report. October income was \$425.08, and expenses were \$147.99 (raffle item). If any member wishes to have a copy of the treasurer's report, please contact Doug. A motion to approve the treasurer's report was made and seconded. The report was approved as read by a show of hands.

New Field Search

An update was given on potential flying site #75. Currently, 14 neighbors will need to be formally notified of the zoning request. James has already spoken to all but one neighbor. An ad will need to be run in the Daily Journal as well as the certified letters.

We are proceeding with the zoning petition after all neighbors have been contacted. This includes expenditure of club funds to file the petition and associated fees. Estimated cost is \$700 for the zoning process.

Chuck plans to meet with the zoning board planner on November 17, 2022.

The current officers will remain on as interim officers until new volunteers step forward.


Show and Tell
