

Meeting Minutes

Meeting was called to order by Chuck Baker at 7:33 pm (due to technical issues with the microphone).

16 members, 3 officers and 2 guests were in attendance.

Old Business

Adam Hunt read the December meeting minutes. 1 error was found during the reading. The "Presentation" section indicated "No presentation for November". They should have read "No presentation for December" as indicated in the minutes. There were no additional questions concerning the minutes. A motion to approve the meeting minutes as corrected was made and seconded. The minutes were approved as read by a show of hands.
